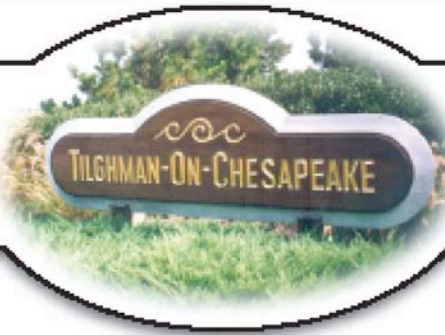

SKIPJACK - 1886

Sails Spring through December

Climb aboard history. Sailing into her 3rd century, REBECCA welcomes you to sail back in time. She was designated a National Historic Landmark in 2003, and is the oldest working skipjack of a vanishing fleet.

Sail with 5th generation Tilghman Island skipper Capt. Wade Murphy, Jr., for a hands-on sailing experience while hearing stories of Chesapeake ecology, maritime history, nautical anecdotes, and even dredge for oysters. USCG certified for 49 passengers.

In the late 1890s hundreds of skipjacks plied the Chesapeake Bay to dredge for oysters. Today only a dozen working boats remain. For sail information call 410-829-3976 or visit www.skipjack.org.
